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# COMMUNITY SCHOOL OF THE ARTS 2023-2024 COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

### DANCE AND MOVEMENT CLASS

CONTEMPORARY & MODERN DANCE (Ages 7 and up)

Mondays, 5:30 - 6:30 P.M.

Instructor: Rose Attea

This one-hour class will help dancers connect movement to emotions, helping them to become storytellers through the art of dance and movement. The class will focus on body awareness, across the floor combinations and technique, choreography, while also exploring their own creative freedom and expression. Dancers will be introduced to guided improv and partner improv. This class will be offered in two levels.

#### PERCUSSION ENSEMBLE

PERCUSSION ARTS ENSEMBLE (Grades 6 - 12)

Tuesdays, 4:30 – 6:00 PM

Instructor: Nate Barrett

Inspired by "Stomp!" this 90-minute class focuses on all aspects of percussive arts, including basic rhythm fundamentals, classifications of instruments, and ear training. Students learn to compose complex rhythms, improvise, work as an ensemble, and incorporate the rhythms of everyday life into formal compositions.

### **VISUAL ARTS CLASSES**

EXPLORATIONS IN ART I (Grades 5 - 6)

Tuesdays, 4:30 - 6:00 P.M. Instructor: Leann Cooper

EXPLORATIONS IN ART II (Grades 7 – 8)

Wednesdays, 4:30 - 6:00 P.M.

In these 90-minute classes, students will begin by honing their drawing skills and then move on to watercolor basics and other painting techniques. Toward the end of the year, students will upcycle unconventional materials into new masterpieces. All skill levels welcome.

MAKING IT! (Grades 9 - 10) Thursdays, 4:30 - 6:00 P.M. Instructor: Jennifer Willard

In this 90-minute mixed media class, students will explore the fine line between art and craft, creating many elements of art-making themselves. Projects include clay, printmaking, paper-making, fiber arts, scratch building — all to create sculptures and mixed media paintings and collages on board, canvas, and paper. All skill levels welcome.

SERIOUS ABOUT ART (BUT STILL HAVING FUN) (Grades 10 - 12)

Mondays, 4:00 - 6:00 P.M. Instructor: Ashton Ludden

This two-hour class is best suited for those wanting to advance themselves in their artistic practice, no matter what their skill set. This class primarily focuses on 2D processes such as printmaking, drawing, bookmaking, design, and mixed media. In addition to honing formal techniques, students also explore how drawing can help you think with best practices in sketchbooking, creating individualized projects to build an art portfolio, and discuss professional practices such as properly documenting artwork or applying to an exhibition.

## **PRIVATE MUSIC LESSONS**

MUSICAL INSTRUMENT LESSONS (Grades 2 and up)

Weekly private lessons (30 minutes to 1 hour) are offered in beginning, intermediate, and advanced levels for the following instruments. All disciplines include instruction in music theory and composition. Instruments are provided for students who do not have their own.
